A Warm Greeting To All:

The Fall Feasts are upon us. Last minute preparations for these Feasts are under way. Always, there is much to do -- things which cannot be done until the final weeks leading up to the Feast.

The success of it largely depends on the attitudes we all bring with us. Come to fulfill the purpose and will of God, and the success of the Feast is assured.

CURRENT EVENTS

Is there any question about the direction world events are taking at this time? Those with eyes to see and the mind to comprehend know the basics. Keep your eyes fixed on international banking and economics. Watch carefully all political maneuvering — especially in many sensitive areas of the world. Central and South America. All these areas will indubitably play significant roles in the development of the final structured Babylonian Empire.

Watch events as they unfold in the Church. From all indications, you are not going to see the unfolding panorama of events unless your eyes are fixed where they should be. For the very inherent reasons in the above statement, most who once knew the Truth of God will miss entirely this final emerging scenario.

Read the prophecies which relate to the last days -- regularly. Just avoid the temptation to ascribe them to specific times and places. Let the actual events themselves reveal the intent and purpose. For God alone knows and understands the intent He wrote into those prophecies.

ARTICLES

The first half (section) of the healing article has been typed, edited, and is now in the process of proofreading. Once this action has been completed and the necessary corrections made, the article (first section) will be sent to the printers. We hope to have this part done and ready for distribution at the Feast of Tabernacles this year. All effort will be made to finish the second section (Biblical) in just a matter of weeks after the Feast. It will be expeditiously mailed to you. It is our desire to submit the whole of the article at the earliest possible convenience. By the time you read and digest the first section, we think we will have the last part available.

When not involved in proofreading and other duties regarding the preparation of the healing article, work is being done on the next major article we feel needs to be completed and submitted. This major work will probably require a minimum period of two years. However, we will be submitting shorter works which will fill in this gap of time. For instance, the article on the calendar is being readied for typing, editing, and proofreading. Mr. Robert Jacobs is making progress in the writing of this much needed article.
