Announcement Letter
December 1983

Warmest Greetings To You All:

On the contrary, they will be greatly ridiculed and despised. intensity of the trials grows, the hate and contempt will augment. general, people are never appreciative for knowledge or help given if it counters that which they elect to believe, or perhaps better stated, The sum of the above is this: The that which they wish to believe. people of God are at the threshold of very trying and difficult times. Though protected, as God promised, the reality of the curses pronounced for the last days will be seen and felt. Even a "place of safety" is no picnic. There are incredible hardships involved in any dislocation. No matter what that protection is or where it occurs, we will be subjected to a time of faith refinement. Now is the time to prepare hearts and minds for this inevitable eventuality.

## CURRENT EVENTS

Watch for more and more, and at the same time increasingly more fanatical, demonstrations from militant groups demanding a

surrender of U.S. principles and objectives inherent in the constitutional basis of our government. Who can fault the concept of peace? But when the word "peace" is used to hide the real objective, the wary and honest must ask why a very real dichotomy of directional emphasis exists. That is, why are those so strongly opposed to nuclear proliferation singularly against the United States? Has no one told them that there are two great nuclear powers? And, in fact, the one has manifested no honest willingness to reduce their weapons, or even the tensions which so adversely affect all nations at this present If people are not going to trust God as they were instructed to do, common sense tells us that they had better trust that which they can devise for themselves. Even God told ancient Israel, after they had rejected Him from being their direct King and military Commander, that they should go up to battle against their enemies. responsible for the conscription laws which we find in the Pentateuch. Yet in all this, those physical people chosen by God to be His peculiar people were warned against allowing themselves to begin trusting in "horses" for their protection. In other words, what God required was a continuous trust in Him even though the Israelites wanted to be politically and militarily like all other nations. The United States and Great Britain are the modern-day descendants of ancient Israel. is only those spiritually called of God who can implicitly trust Him without some visible prop -- a king or a standing army. As nations not called of God, spiritually, it would not have been wrong for them to maintain their military strength and power. But while manifesting a physical orientation, they should have continued to exhibit strong moral principles of honesty, industry, compassion, and loyalty -loyalty to letter obedience, even if real spiritual obedience is impossible.

For now, I must avoid taking sufficient time and space to evaluate other problems extant in the world. Indeed, there are many. And the time of reality will come altogether too soon.
