Our Very Dear Brethren:

Warmest greetings once again. The year 1984 is well underway. To the average and undiscerning eye conditions look pretty much normal. What really counts is not what is seen, but what is transpiring behind the scene. That is quite another matter. Though we must not build castles and images of sand, we most assuredly must be alert and observant — aware of the times and circumstances in which we live. Nowhere in all the Bible is there an indication that the events of the last days might be changed by human efforts. The events prophesied for the traumatic last days will happen exactly as God had them recorded. The only defect relative to these events is man's understanding of the times involved.

What is happening all around us in our physical world?

#### CURRENT EVENTS

Giving you an analysis of relevant events of these days without putting emphasis on times or specifics is a most difficult task. Much thought has been given to the nature of subjects to present. What are the telltale manifestations of the last days? A generalized outline has been developed. Though all facets of that outline will not be included in each Announcement Letter, those subjects demanding some consideration will be analyzed. We hope the thoughts will be helpful — that the material itself will induce you to a further and more intense observation and evaluation of these days as they unfold.

The above-mentioned outline was developed for us many, many years ago. It is the very format by which the evil and nefarious forces are attempting to bring about the one-world government mentioned in the Bible -- called Babylon, the Great. What are the varying facets of Babylonianism? This Babylonianism embraces every concept of men -- as well as all races and nations existing on this earth. Simply stated Babylonianism consists of six divisions of operation. They are: 1. politics, 2. economy, 3. religion, 4. military, 5. education, and 6. society (social). Within these broad categories will fall every detail of its operation.

Although not complete, the following list will help you to grasp the meaning and direction of the events unfolding. But, let me stress once again, we are not stating absolutes. The most we wish you to accept from the material presented is that all the actions and events of these days do in some way relate to the prophetic events Christ said were destined to transpire before His glorious return to set everything in order once again (Acts 3:19-21). You are commanded to "watch." In order to do this successfully, it is imperative that you have some mental fabric into which to assign the significance of the events themselves.

Most of the material which you will be receiving you will have heard or read. Our usage of the items will simply give you some idea of what we consider relevant and important for the month. We hope this approach will help you. But, do not assume we are <u>predicting or specifically</u> applying any of the material. We can stop this presentation as easily as it was begun. We can know the specifics only when and if God makes them known. When that happens, we will be absolute, if we are the ones chosen to communicate them to His own called and chosen servants.

So that you may have the format in mind, the following lists will indicate what is basically covered under each of the above six broad categories. Some semblance of order will help both you and us.

Here are various subjects covered under each broad category.

- 1. POLITICS: elections, bureaucracy, surveillance, wars, taxation, control, philosophy, citizens' response, judicial, and international affairs.
- ECONOMICS: banking, monetary control, interest, industry, business, commerce, agriculture, internationalism, labor, and regulations.
- 3. MILITARY: purposes, draft, philosophy, equipment, space, control, operations, quality, morale, and conflicts.
- 4. EDUCATION: primary, secondary, and advanced education, philosophy, objectives, testing, quality, facilities, orientation, private, legalities, advertising, teachers, and students.
- 5. RELIGION: ecumenism, churches, eastern philosophy, occult, evangelicals, homosexual churches, charismatics, changes, operations, and WWC.

6. SOCIETY (social): revolution, marriage, divorce, family, entertainment, immorality, music, alcoholism, drugs, smoking, disease, crime, work and welfarism, and attitude.

The above are basic subjects. Much could be added to them, but what is listed is sufficient to organize our thinking.

One other point needs to be added to this outline before proceeding to the remainder of the <u>Announcement Letter</u>. That is, the above does not take into consideration the fact that many of the difficulties to be experienced in the last days will come as a direct result of God's intervention in the affairs of men. Mankind is to receive the full brunt of God's punishment for its rebellion and disobedience. What appears to be a direct result of that intervention will be listed under different headings. As time progresses, these particular headings will be developed.

## ARTICLES

The healing article is enclosed. We are most happy to submit this final segment of the healing article. We do trust and pray that you will find it most rewarding and informational. We feel most rewarded and trust that you will feel the same way about it.

Work is progressing on the next subject which we have elected to undertake at this time — the subject of Israel and the Church. We do sincerely desire an interest in your prayers regarding the research and writing of this article, or perhaps book. By far, this will prove to be the most difficult subject undertaken. Your prayers should be of very great comfort and assistance to us.

Work continues on the calendar article. However, each time we feel adequate material has been digested to write the article effectively, other meaningful data comes along. Wanting the article to be thorough and well documented, we will take the time to complete it in an exhaustive manner. We do thank you for your continued patience. The future results will be more than rewarding.

As indicated in a previous issue of this <u>Letter</u>, there will probably be a couple of articles submitted before the completion of the major work on the subject of Israel and the Church. These articles will be compilations of material covered in other ways in the past.
