What a time to represent the new life which God has promised to those who will obey Him.

CURRENT EVENTS

Taxation: Politicians have not gotten the message yet. They are incessantly talking about adding or increasing taxes. At the same time the tax revolt is growing by leaps and bounds. Citizens have finally learned that legislative avenues mean absolutely nothing. Whatever the brand of politics, the end result is the same, heavier taxes and more control over their lives. Realizing this, many are now resorting to moves which they can personally make. Even those who still use the legislative means to achieve their ends are demanding a more direct part in any legislation which directly affects their lives.

From all appearances, and from what we are reading, a real tax revolution is on its way. We may be seeing some of the preparation essential to the fulfillment of many of the terrible catastrophes prophesied for these last days. Just remember, there is always the groundwork preparation before the reality of the event.

Education: Changes are occurring at an accelerated pace. Many areas are attempting to establish "International Schools," especially at the secondary level. These schools will teach from a one-world perspective. Nationalism will be eliminated entirely.

At the same time the world education philosophy is gaining strength, the deterioration of all moral values continues. In the sense of real basic education, schooling today is a farce. All parents who care about what their children are absorbing through the medium of classroom instruction had better be aware of what is transpiring. Parents need to take the time to find out what their children are being

taught. Then, they should take measures to counteract this insidious propaganda by a concerted effort in the home.

Control: In subtle ways, usually with a facade of social value, restrictive legislation and directives are being established. When mankind finally comes to its senses, it will be too late for it to do anything about the restrictions being imposed. However, generally speaking, these losses of freedom are coming as a direct curse from God because this nation has refused to obey Him. God is using the Babylonian system of these last days to punish His people, as well as all peoples around the world. Those who know and understand the Truth will be restricted, too, but due to the fact they will be able to see into the future, based on the promises of God, they will not worry themselves unduly because of these problems. It will not be easy to maintain a tranquil and peaceful mind through these tragic times. But, we must manifest the faith necessary to gain entrance into the promised Kingdom of God at the return of Jesus Christ.

Israel and the Church: Major problems and questions are arising. The subject itself is not under question. The problems lie within the "proof" employed by organizations which have written about and tainted the whole subject. We cannot use material created out of whole cloth. Most proof presented is obviously the machinations, mentally, of those who had a concept and then set about proving it.

We have pretty well decided to use only the Bible as the basis of our presentation and add substantiated historical evidence. This approach may prove to be more interesting anyway. The promises of God as well as Biblical statements about Israel are the strongest proof. Those promises must be realized. God bound Himself inexorably to perform the conditions of the agreements between Himself and the patriarchs.
