We do try as effectively as we know how to commute out into those areas where we can maximize our endeavor for the limited time available. Current Events

There is something ominous about the events of the last few weeks. Even though we cannot understand the reality and meaning of these events, we must not allow ourselves to be drugged by the opiate of indifference, doubt, hardness, or by a critical posture. There is something which God requires us to watch and about which we must become emotionally involved. God's instruction is not for naught.

What are some of those events? The passing from the scene of a number of devoted, faithful members. Aged, yes! But that factor alone cannot answer all the fundamental questions involved in these dramatic circumstances. Are they taken from the evils to come? What was the purpose of this great loss in so short a time?

The death of Mr. Herbert W. Armstrong. For those who understand in part what happened in the catastrophic years, 1972 - 1974, the death of Mr. Armstrong seemingly represents the passing of an era. It forebodes significant and troubling events. We are aware of the Biblical indications relevant to this time -- events which will most directly affect the church which once taught the Truth. This event precipitated an emotional response of great sorrow by those of us here at Eugene. We can now only wonder what lies ahead. Whatever it is, we know for certain the picture is not one to produce optimistic exuberance. I hope we are all prepared for the events which lie in front of us.

What once was a far-off, merely read-about reality has become a nightmare in the United States -- terrorism. It has affected travel and tourism in general. The reality of it has affected the response of nearly every department of the Federal government. When there is no sanctity to life, there is no fear. When there is no fear for one's own personal life, there is no constraint to maintain basic order in a legally constituted society. As bad as these purposes are, these people are dying for cause. Surely Christians should understand that action.

What is most devastating is the fear of an uncontrollable spread of virulent diseases. At this time, fear almost reigns. Yet the real truth cannot be advanced due to highly specialized interests. Some people, lifestyles, and ordinary practices are going to be indicted eventually. What is happening to this world is the consequence of man's rebellion against God. There is no way science, the world's god, can make these consequences go away. They are going to become more devastating and lethal. Will our faith sustain us?

Other events and circumstances could be mentioned; however, it is not deemed imperative or even needful at this present time. The above points illustrate the severity of the times in which we live. Has our confidence been tested? Are we questioning or troubled? Do we have our faith and personal conviction in order? You will never endure if you have not purposed that resolve now -- in the better times of our own existence. Do not wait to shore up faith and conviction until the day the need exists. That time is too late!
