Dear Brethren:

One half of Summer '87 is history. It has been a very different one to most of us. We can only hazardously guess at what the future may bring.

With the erratic weather has come a pest problem which is virtually uncontrollable. What does this forebode for the future? What we do know is this: Circumstances cannot improve before they become much worse—devastatingly so.

Current Events

America is in the midst of a serious epidemic. It should be called "gatitis," that is, "gateitis" (Irangate/Contragate). In the political arena little constructive work is being done. Americans are paying the healthy salaries of far too many individuals who are doing virtually nothing but seeking ways to intimidate those who have opposing views and who have sought ways to implement those views. It is here that the above disease becomes most virulent. If anything has been learned from all the special prosecutions of the past, it is this: Hypocrisy is the name of the game. How many of those who were prosecuting the accused, lecturing in august terms about right and wrong, moralizing in ostentatious fashion, and creating public image for self or a particular party, are clean and honest? America's memory is so short. In past "gate" situations, it later becomes apparent many of those involved had blacker hearts and more tainted practices than those accused.

Do you ever get a sickening feeling in the pit of the stomach as you read the reports of the day's activities, or watch proceedings on the television set? Do you generally respond on the basis of past party or geographic inclinations? If you have feelings of indignation, could you really give good, profound reason? Are we reacting on the basis of slanted reporting? Remember, some men are incredibly capable of creating emotional reactions—but those reactions are foundationless and without acceptable purpose! That is, the emotional response is not based on absolute facts but a falsely created image. Further, the purpose is to control and manipulate the masses for some ulterior objective.

If the real purpose of these investigations were to uncover evil, wrongdoing, in high places in our government, then many whys need to be addressed. Why the calamitous disaster at Pearl Harbor? Why the fiasco at the Bay of Pigs? Why the creation of a no-win situation in Korea and Vietnam? Why the deliberate hiding of information regarding the death of John F. Kennedy? Why is America supplying food, materials, and technology to an archenemy, Russia? Why have we basically turned our backs on Taiwan and given preferential treatment to

China—an avowed enemy? Why the overt un-American activities which we are daily forced to face—organizations, causes, etc.? The list could go on and on ad nauseum.

Sufficient is said, in the context of this Letter, to give you the picture of hypocrisy. In the days of Jesus Christ, He was faced with the same ribald nature of man. Men have only degenerated from that day to the present. Should we expect them to be better today?

Now, as never before, is the time to pray: "Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven" (Matt. 6:10). Conditions will never be any different until man is no longer allowed to rule. The real rulers will be the called who have come to see themselves for what they are and have done an acceptable job of mastering that nature. These will be born into the family of God, with the divine nature.

What a joy to anticipate!
