Announcement Letter September 1988

Dear Brethren:

Very warm greetings to all. The Feast of Tabernacles and the Last Great Day are fast approaching. With the passing of this past year, we are now one year closer to a gloriously anticipated day—a day just like the present one—the day of Christ's Second Coming. In that day, if we have been faithful—living obediently to all we know and understand—we can confidently stand before Christ—not in self-confidence, but in a glorious confidence in His mercy and compassion.

Just the very thought of that anticipated meeting should make our lives tingle with excitement and purpose. The only cloud which presently effaces that thrill is the prophetic knowledge that some will be devastatingly disappointed. They will hear the voice of Christ say: "Depart from me, ye that work iniquity" (Matt. 7:23). Weeping and gnashing of teeth will follow. This need not be the fate of any one of us. All we need do is decide we will be faithful and master the self at all cost. The decision is ours. All the help needed has been assured.

We have come this far, why should we allow ourselves to fail *now*? Let us pray for one another. Let us turn to the strength and power of God and His Son Jesus Christ. They have a desire for the workmanship of their hands. They will see us through the dark and cloudy times which lie ahead, if we will it that way. The Feast is an excellent time and opportunity to recharge our spiritual batteries. Renewed with a determination to be successful, we can make this Feast exemplary of all that the Kingdom of God represents to us.

Current Events

This is an election year. The airwaves are filled with promises. Promises which no candidate intends to keep. Or cannot keep because of our system of government. If you were to believe each candidate on the basis of promises, the next administration should border on utopia. But the past, for the analytical, proves that all such promises are baseless palaver. Knowing the Truth, we have come to recognize and believe there is no hope in governments of men. In fact, we are specifically told the Kingdom of Christ is not of this world, John 18:36–37. The ultimate is total servitude—as vassals. They are destined to become the bondservants of the presumed elite.

With this election, we can be assured the realizations of their nefarious purposes will take another giant step forward toward complete and ultimate fulfillment.

Let us not be concerned or anxious. The God of all "gods" still resides in the heavens. He knows who the faithful are. We can have all confidence in His superior purposes. You are a part of that great spiritual purpose.
