## Announcement Letter June 1998

#### Dear Brethren:

There seems to be no area of the United States of America—indeed, of the world—immune from tragedy. Springfield, Oregon was recently shocked from its slumber—May 22. Though unknown to most humanity until that tragic date, it is well known around the world now.

There will be mountains of discussions, reflections on the past, and a host of "whatifs." But, if the past is any indication, the shock will wear off and little, if anything, will be done about the matter.

How can, or, should we, even expect the unconverted to respond to the underlying societal problems which are being flashed in blazing headlines around the world? When man analyzes he will inevitably employ carnality—the very basis of his problem. Can he under such circumstances ever hope to arrive at acceptable answers? As life continues, men will become more and more hardened. This will be witnessed by the fact that volatility, defiance, and contempt will reign in the days when God begins to correct society for the purpose of softening and bringing them to a teachable orientation. That attitude which is essential for the institution of the new order under Jesus Christ. Please read the sixteenth chapter of Revelation. The hardness seems almost impossible to believe.

The big question right now is this: Is man already experiencing an element of that hardness? Indeed, it is quite likely. Just take a look at those who have turned away from the truth and are again following the dictate of the flock and the carnal mind. It is not hard to

see them in the above picture. Was the Apostle Paul writing of this generation when he wrote Hebrews chapters three and four? Please study them carefully.

Despite the times of contention and strife, I have found great satisfaction in that sacrifice. To my dying day, or change if God so wills it, I want to be able to continue to use all my faculties in that service to which I was called. Please continue to pray for my eyesight and good health. For that kindness, I give you my thanks and appreciation. As Paul said to those whom he served, you are, and will be always, in my heart and mind. God's chosen are priceless in His eyes and also those who are true servants of the children of the Father.
