New Board Members

Due to a number of factors a major overhaul of the church Board is essential this year. These changes must be substantiated by the church membership at the Feast of Tabernacles this Fall.

In the past we tried to accommodate most men of the church. Regardless of age or years in the church an effort was made to at some time include them all on the Board for a period of seven years. With the number of Board members being established at seven and a required reinstatement of one member each year, in effect the length of tenure for each member was seven years.

We would still like to keep the required number of members at seven. However, after some deliberation, it was felt imperative that the basic Board should be made up of members of good chronological age as well as years of trial, experience, and proving in the church. Further, it is felt the church would be better served by not removing the older, tried, and proven men from the Board by a tightly controlled rotational system—frequently, therefore, at the end of seven years, to be removed from the Board.

The above considerations must be presented to the church for consideration and approval. Please be thinking about the factors involved. Also, our legal counsel may feel other specifics need to be addressed. If so, those will be presented in the Annual Business Meeting this year.
