Announcement Letter September 2000

Our Beloved Brethren:

Once again God's Fall Feasts are fast approaching. These are times of great enjoyment and spiritual enrichment to all who have mentally performed well for the past year—the time lapse between the conclusion of the Feast last year and the present.

Once again, some will not be present at the Feast! Why? Logic and honesty allow for only three or four possible explanations. None of these reasons will appeal to the offenders. As has always been true, those who lose their way seek explanations which will justify the self. This ministry will not indulge in any form of conciliatory back-slapping or obsequious fraternization. As the called ministry of Jesus Christ, the Truth must be given no matter how it affects us (2 Timothy 4:1–4). The Apostle Paul minced no words when he wrote of these last days. "I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom; Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables."

The unvarnished reasons are as follows: 1) Too many simply did not hear what was said for the past many months. 2) Some have lost faith in that which was delivered. 3) Some have turned to perversions of the Truth in order to protect the self. 4) Some may have lost their perspective due to the times of trouble which Jesus said would transpire in our day. 5) And, finally, there is a good chance some have simply grown weary in well doing.

Whatever the reason, we will always urge them to reconsider, completely repent, and turn back to God. How many will have the courage to face reality and amend their ways?

While our former brothers and sisters of Christ struggle to right themselves, let us, brethren, be praying that our God and Father will assist them to achieve that lofty and rewarding objective. To fail could be a frightening and devastating experience. Neither God

nor Christ, as well as all their earthly friends want to see that happen. On an even more sobering note, brethren, let us guard our minds so that a similar fate does not await any of us.

Again, brethren, we love, admire, and respect everyone who honestly and correctly fulfils the will of God. As always we are your servants.

Returning Used Cassette Tapes

For a good quality recording a tape cannot be reused more than three times. When these tapes come back to the office they are discarded. So, if you receive any tapes that have three marks, there is no need to return them.
