Announcement Letter February 2011

Dear Brethren:

Thank you for the chance to address you once again in this new issue. Those of you who receive this *Announcement Letter* each month make up the core of our membership worldwide, and we are privileged to be your servants in God's name. It is our hope and prayer that you are holding firm to your faith in the unchanging doctrines of that one true God, and that you are finding the means to grow ever closer to Him through the power of Jesus Christ.

The Monthly Letter included in this mailing is always available to the whole world from our website, but this particular letter is provided primarily to those who express a special interest in having a more direct connection with this fellowship. It is not that there is anything really special, let alone secret, in the content of this letter, but it has always been used—initially by Mr. Raymond Cole, and now by yours truly—as a means to speak more personally each month to our faithful members scattered around the world. Often, when new contacts seek to join our fellowship, we are asked, "What do I have to do to be a member?" We have no official membership process, no screening of applicants, and no initiations to complete. It is simply a matter of someone choosing to receive our materials and thereby becoming fed by that spiritual meat provided in sermons and letters. Furthermore, it involves the choice (for those who are physically able) to travel to fellowship in person at Church of God, The Eternal assemblies on weekly or annual Sabbaths, especially at the Feast of Tabernacles. But there again, the individual is totally in control of that process. Those who share an agreement with what we are doing and who believe that this ministry is truly speaking with the authority of Jesus Christ are free to participate in any of those assemblies. So once again, "membership" is totally in the hands of the individual. We do not erect obstacles or impediments to make that process difficult. Just desire earnestly to be part of us, and then prove it by going out of your way to assemble with us peacefully in those holy convocations (whenever possible), and that pretty much makes you a member.

We hope that these efforts to provide recorded sermons and monthly mailings are a blessing to you. We know that it must be so for many of you because you provide feedback to us about the specific content which demonstrates you are listening, reading, and studying that material intently. That is always gratifying to your devoted servants who spend much time and effort in preparing those lessons. At the same time, simple probability suggests that a certain percentage of the letters and sermons we mail out may simply be relegated to a closet shelf without a glance. It may be that someone who initially wanted the material has since flagged in his enthusiasm, but yet hesitates to ask to be removed from our mailing list. Or, it

may be that some of you are sincere in wanting to be part of this fellowship, but find it difficult to make time to study the material you receive from us. We hope the sermons and letters are tools you are using actively to help enhance your relationship with God. That is our sole intent for producing and distributing all of it. But to what extent it is valued is a very personal and individual consideration. Like membership, use of those sermons and letters is according to your own personal volition. We do not quiz you on the content. We will never try to force any of you to "jump through hoops" to remain a member in good standing, or to feel part of this remnant fellowship. The membership which truly matters is *the invisible membership* in the Body of Jesus Christ—the Church—and that membership list is not controlled by us or any other human beings. God only decides who is found on that list, and He decides what is your membership standing at any given time. He is the One who judges our hearts and knows whether in private we are truly devoted and enthusiastic members. He also knows whether the tools being offered by the inspiration of His chosen servants are being utilized wisely by each one of us.

We, as your humble physical servants, will always assume the best concerning each one of you, and we will do all within our power to encourage and support you in that spiritual walk. But please know that you do not have to prove anything to us. We will never be your judges. God has given us neither the capacity nor the authority to do that job. He has reserved that to Himself, and we are very thankful simply to stay discretely within the bounds of our limited authority and to be the messengers of His divine instruction in these last days. May you be edified, enlightened, and enriched by His loving care and guidance.
