This is the true new year, and it cannot help but solicit in our minds a nostalgic review of the past twelve months, coupled with anticipation for the next ones before us. What will this new year bring? Will we continue much as we have in the past few decades? Or instead, will things change dramatically for those of this scattered remnant body? God does not intend for any of us to know those answers in advance, but He has promised to provide for every need, no matter how harrowing circumstances in this world may become. To that end we wish to renew our declaration to serve you as long as God makes it possible for us to do so. Indeed you are few and scattered, but you are among those rare ones today who understand the real Truth about God's plan for humanity, and you are among those few with whom God is aggressively working now to grant salvation at the Second Coming of His dear Son.
