Dear Brethren:

Special greetings to our friends and brethren around the world, with expressions of love and solidarity for all who are seeking to hold firm to God's revealed way of life. Your support for this little remnant body continues to be consistent, both materially and spiritually, and we thank you for being a key part of our ability to continue to do this work of service to all who have come to value the doctrines of the true Jesus Christ.

This is the month in which we will keep that very significant Holy Day, Pentecost. It is significant because of its meaning in God's comprehensive plan in dealing with the human family, detailing a "time of salvation" for a firstfruits harvest, separate and distinct from God's work with the majority of the world.
