# Announcement Letter February 2020

#### Dear Brethren:

While the world becomes a darker and darker place—as we rocket toward the end of this age—the called people of God have reason to be the happiest people on earth. If that sounds counterintuitive, given the serious trials and burdens that come automatically with trying to live a godly life within an increasingly hostile environment, that is understandable. However, it is true nonetheless.

If the world hate you, ye know that it hated me before it hated you. If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you. Remember the world that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also. But all these things will they do unto you for my name's sake, because they know not him that sent me (John 15:18–21).

My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing (James 1:2–4).

These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world (John 16:33).

Because of who each of you is in God's glorious plan, you remain special to all of us who are dedicated to your spiritual service, and we greet you in this new month with our appreciation, our devotion, and our commitment to serving you to the very limits of our abilities.
